Start at the trailhead on the west side of the coast highway.



Walk as if you were going to walk up Humbug Mountain, but when the trail turns left (West), you should go East. After a short distance there will be a tunnel under the highway, followed by a bridge over the creek.



Take a left at the campground road, and follow it to just beyond site 34. There will be a trail on the right with a sign for Amphitheater.

That trail will wind around for about a half a mile through trees and ferns until it meets the Coast Trail (old highway 101).







<u>Turn left on the Coast Trail</u> and follow it past a water tank and later a picnic table with a view (near a utility pole).

About 100 steps beyond the picnic table (depending on your stride) there will be an unmarked path off to the left.



## **Humbug Mountain Park--Coast Trail**





Take that for a good view of the ocean, Humbug Mountain, and Port Orford. Return to the Coast Trail from the viewpoint, and continue along the Coast Trail for about another mile before you spot another trail off on the left (this one marked as Viewpoint).





Take that trail until you find a geology marker and a bench. You'll again have good views of the surrounding areas and you might want to stop here for a snack.

This could be a turnaround point, or you could return to the trail and proceed about another quarter mile to a picnic table.

You could go further beyond the picnic table, but there's nothing notable, and by turning around here the total hike will be about four miles.

On the return trip the most important thing to do is watch out for the trail to the campground. It's marked.
