Hiking Good Sense

Only cross Highway 101 at stoplights. Wait for the "Walk" signal.

Walk on the sidewalk or pathway.

When you must walk on the road, stay on the shoulder. Walk on the left side of the roadway so you are facing the oncoming traffic.

If you walk after dark, carry a light and turn it on when cars are present.

Be prepared for the weather to get cooler. Carry another layer for warmth.

Respect property. The hike route will not take you onto private property.

Special Note: If you take this hike when school is in session. Respect the security and safety concerns of our schools and walk outside of school grounds.
